Dear Developer,

I am to refer letter No. K-43014(16)/5/2020-SEZ dated 9 August 2021 of Department of Commerce on the subject cited above wherein it has been conveyed that the Department has examined the issue in consultation with Department of Expenditure and decided following relief for SEZ Units on account of COVID-19 outbreak:

- A. No increase in lease rent for the SEZ Units for the FY 2021-22
- B. Payment of Lease rent of first quarter is to be deferred upto 31st July, 2021 for all SEZ Units. The deferment may not invite any interest thereof.
