1. Background

Noida Export Processing Zone (NEPZ) was set up in 1985 as an industrial and services zone for generating economic activity through exports while creating employment and attracting investment. Subsequently, in 2000 the Special Economic Zone (SEZ) policy was formulated and it was renamed as the Noida Special Economic Zone (NSEZ). A standalone SEZ Policy came up in 2005 with the SEZ Rules made in 2006. The zone is spread over 310 acres and has 202 plots and 14 Standard Design Factories (SDFs). There are around 260 functional units in the zone which are into manufacturing, services, trading and warehousing. The total employment in the zone is around 40,000 with annual exports of around Rs 80,000 crores and investment to the tune of Rs 120,000 crores.

2. Terms of Reference

NSEZ would hire two electric buses of upto 40 Seater capacity for a period of 5 years to provide regular Bus Service inside the Noida Special Economic Zone.

The following will be the Terms and Conditions:-

- a. The OEM will own, maintain and operate (including providing the driver) the service. They will also provide a fast charger for charging of the buses. While the service provided will establish the charging point, the office of NSEZ would provide electric supply.
- b. The OEM will provide digital interface to monitor the live feed and usage of the bus;
- c. The total distance covered by the vehicle shall be 80-100 Kms in a day.
- d. Uptime of 90% shall be maintained by the operator.
- e. The lease period would be maximum for five years; which may be renewed upon satisfactory performance.
- f. All the legal compliance related to the vehicles, drivers etc would be the duty of the Service provider.

3. Qualification Criteria

The qualification criteria for the applicant would be as under:

- i. Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM)
- ii. Not blacklisted by any agency

Preference would be given to persons

- i. Who have supplied electric buses to government, either central, state or local governments for their operations or public transport
- ii. Who have supplied electric buses to private or joint venture entities for their own or other operations.

The bidders would need to provide details on the organisation to which these buses were supplied including the number of buses and the period of contract.

4. Format for application:

Interested applicants may kindly submit their brochure, highlighting the qualification criteria mentioned above. Documentary proof in support of the criteria would also need to be submitted by the applicants.

5. Selection Procedure

EOIs received shall be examined by an internal committee who would shortlist the applicants based on the qualification criteria. The committee reserves the right to seek any additional information or documents from the applicants.

6. The Bid Language would be in English.

7. EMD and Performance Security would be applicable as per prevalent norms.

8. Scope of work- to and fro movement from Gate 1 and/or 2 to designated pick up and drop points of persons working in Noida SEZ.
