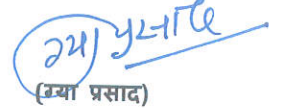

Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting in respect of SEZs located in the State of Haryana, held under the Chairmanship of Shri A. Bipin Menon, Development Commissioner, NSEZ at 10:30 AM on 04/07/2024.

The following members of Approval Committee were present during the meeting:-

1. Shri Surender Malik, Joint Development Commissioner, NSEZ.
 2. Shri I.S. Yadav, Asstt. Director, Department of Industries, Gurugram.

- Besides, during the meeting i). Shri Gya Prasad, DDC, ii). Shri Surender Singh Yadav, Specified Officer, iii). Shri Prakash Chand Upadhyay, ADC & iv) Shri Sunil Gulyani, Stenographer /Dealing hand, were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the quorum was available and the meeting could proceed.
 - At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After a brief introduction, the agenda was taken up sequentially. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the developers / units, the following decisions were taken unanimously:-

1. Ratification of the Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting held on 06.06.2024:-

As no reference in respect of the decisions of the Approval Committee held on 06.06.2024 was received from any of the members of the Approval Committee or trade, the Minutes of the Meeting held on 06.06.2024 were ratified.

Item No. 2: Proposal for setting up of new unit:-

2.1: M/s. Leapedge Aerospace And Defense Technologies Private Limited.

2.1.1. M/s. Leapedge Aerospace And Defense Technologies Private Limited had submitted proposal for setting up a unit over a built-up area of 21748 Sqft (2020.45 Sqmt.) in the GTV Tech SEZ Pvt. Ltd. Electronic Hardware IT/ITES SEZ at Village Ghamroj, Tehsil-Sohna, Distt-Gurugram (Haryana), for manufacturing of goods and services as under:-

2.1.2. The applicant had proposed export of Rs.8495.49 lakhs and cumulative NFE of Rs.518.64 lakhs over a period of five years. The projected investment of Rs.3600.00 lakhs towards imported capital goods and Rs.1375.00 lakhs towards indigenous capital goods were proposed. The Applicant had also proposed indigenous input services of Rs.1772.65 lakhs.

2.1.3. It was informed to the Committee that following shortcomings were observed in the application in the first instance:-

- i. Total proposed expenditure of imported & indigenous capital goods, raw materials, input services for 5 years came to Rs.12867.90 lakhs which is much greater than the proposed export of Rs. 8495.49 lakhs. Therefore, the project did not seem financially viable.
- ii. In list of indigenous raw materials, HS Code of 'Mechanical Enclosure- Aluminum structure' had been mentioned as '73011000', which seemed incorrect as Chapter-73 is related to 'Articles of Iron or steel'.
- iii. In the indigenous capital goods the applicant had proposed HS Code 94054900 for 'Furniture'. However, description of this HS Code is 'Other' and is related to "*Chandeliers and other electric ceiling or wall lighting fittings, excluding those of a kind used for lighting public open spaces or thoroughfares*".
- iv. In the list of indigenous capital goods, 'Vehicles- ITC(HS) Code 87032191' had been proposed. The applicant had informed that it would be used for movement of employees to visit vendors, customers and any other purpose for business operations. The applicant had declared that they would not avail any tax benefits. However, the applicant needed to remove the 'Vehicle' from the list of indigenous capital goods and submit revised list as the value of the same for Rs. 35.00 lakhs has been included in the proposed indigenous capital goods of Rs.1375.00 lakhs.
- v. In the list of imported capital goods 'Documentation (HS Code-

4911990)' had been proposed. In this regard, the applicant had stated that these documentations were hard copies of production plans and processes, engineering drawings, industrialization processes, quality and test plans etc. This documentation is to be followed for manufacturing specific products. In future, company would have to import specific documentation on production processes for manufacturing of customized products. The applicant has requested to consider HS Code 49119920- *Plan and drawing for architectural engineering, industrial, commercial, topographical or similar purpose reproduced with the aid for computer or any other devices*. As unit in its reply had stated that they would import specific documentation on production processes for manufacturing of customized products for which unit is required to mention the name of import of specific documentation along with the correct nomenclature.

2.1.4. Further, it was informed that as per directions of the Approval Committee given in its meeting held on 04.04.2024, copies of letter dated 17.12.2015 & 16.11.2017 issued by DoC in respect of M/s. Defsys Solutions Private Limited was forwarded vide this office letter dated 19.04.2024 to DoC seeking information regarding change, if any, in policy provisions in respect of proposed item of manufacture. A reminder letter dated 01.07.2024 had also been sent to DoC. However, reply from DoC is still awaited.

2.1.5. Group Captain S.K. Dwivedi, CEO and Shri Yogender Mittal, Finance Manager of M/s. Leapedge Aerospace And Defense Technologies Private Limited appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. The representatives informed that they would be manufacturing the goods and providing services primarily for civil aviation companies. Their Business Agreement will be with civil aviation OEMs (original equipment manufacturers) like Boeing & Airbus. But being a Tier-2 supplier they would supply the manufactured items through Tier-1 suppliers. They would also doing service activities like assembly, integration and testing in respect of items proposed to be manufactured.

2.1.6. The Approval Committee discussed the proposal in detail and after due deliberations, directed that the proposal may be processed on file for issuance of Letter of Approval, after receipt of required information in respect of letters dated 17.12.2015 & 16.11.2017 from DoC as well as documents pointed out at Para 2.1.3 from the applicant. The Committee further directed to forward the details of business plan of proposed unit specifically mentioning that they will be doing export to civil aviation OEMs or tier 1 suppliers of these OEMs only for civilian purposes only. Moreover, a reminder seeking inputs of DOC would also be sent.

4.1.2. It was informed to the Committee that as per APRs, the unit had pending export realization of Rs.3161.60 lakhs during 1st block, Rs.6211.07 lakhs during 2nd block and Rs.5378.27 lakhs during 3rd block, for which unit has not submitted the permission for extension of time from RBI/AD Bank for realization of pending foreign exchange. Further, DTA sales of Rs. 371.70 lakhs was shown in APRs for FY 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14.


4.1.3. Shri Suraj Gujaran, Associate Principal, Shri Nilesh Patel, Program Manager & Shri Prem Kumar, Process Manager of M/s. The representatives informed that the all DTA sales have been made against payment in USD. They further informed that all pending foreign exchange have been realized.
