

Minutes of the Approval Committee Meeting of Jaipur Special Economic Zone, Sitapura (Multi Product SEZ) held at 10:45 AM on 16.06.2022 under the chairmanship of Shri A. Bipin Menon, Development Commissioner through Video Conferencing.

The Chairman welcomed the participants at the outset and then agenda items were taken up for deliberation one by one. 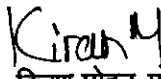

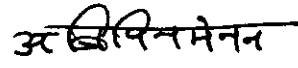
4.2.4 Shri Mithesh Kumar Jain, Manager, appeared before the Approval Committee through video conferencing and explained the proposal.
