Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting of Mahindra World City (Jaipur) Ltd. Multi-Product SEZ, Jaipur, held under the Chairmanship of Shri Gopal Meena, Development Commissioner, NSEZ at 12.00 Noon on 17.09.2026 in Hybrid mode at Conference Hall at 2nd Floor of O/o DC, NSEZ, Noida and through Video Conferencing.

A. The following members of Approval Committee were present during the meeting through video conferencing:-

- i. Shri Paras Mani Tripathi, Joint Development Commissioner, NSEZ
- ii. Shri S.S. Shah, Joint Director Industries, Rajasthan, Jaipur
- iii. Shri Anil Lakhani, Deputy Manager, RIICO, Jaipur.
- iv. Shri Ram Prakash, FTDO, R.L. Meena, Assistant DGFT, Jaipur (Rajasthan).
- v. Shri Vimal Mishra, General Manager, Mahindra World City (Jaipur) Ltd. (representative of SEZ Developer).

B . Besides, during the meeting (i) Shri Salil Gopal Kansal, Specified Officer, Mahindra World City SEZ, Jaipur; (ii) Sh. Ravikesh Tripathy, S.O. NSEZ; and (iii) Shri Sushil Kumar, Assistant Development Commissioner, NSEZ were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the quorum is available and the meeting can proceed.

C . At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After brief introduction, items included in the agenda were taken up for deliberation one by one.

D . The following new initiatives / reforms in view of good governance were taken with the direction of Shri Gopal Meena, IAS, Development Commissioner, NSEZ:-

- Approval letters shall be issued during the meeting itself, immediately after the approval of the Approval Committee.
- Approvals at NSDL portal shall also be given on same day.
- Calendar for conducting the Approval Committee meeting has been issued.
- **The scheduled date of next meeting of Approval Committee is 15.10.2026**
- Only those proposal which are received before five working days of the next scheduled date of the Approval Committee, shall be placed before the Approval Committee.

E . The following references were taken into the account by the Approval Committee while considering the proposals:-

- i. Proviso (1) and (2) of Rule 19 (2) of the SEZ Rules 2006 regarding broad-banding, diversification, enhancement of capacity of production, change in the items of manufacture or service activity, if it meets the requirements of Rule 18;
- ii. Rule 27 (1) and 27 (2) of SEZ Rules 2006 regarding Proviso for import of goods; and
- iii. Instruction No. 109 dated 18.10.2021 for change in partnership deed.

(1): Ratification of the Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting held on 20.08.2026:-

Item No. 2 Proposals for inclusion of additional authorized operations and revision of projections - reg.

2.1 M/s Triumph Motorcycles India Private Limited

2.1.1 It was informed to the Committee that M/s Triumph Motorcycles India Private Limited has submitted proposal for inclusion of additional authorized operation i.e. "Procurement Support Services (CPC 8599)" and revision in projection in the Letter of Approval.

2.1.2 Sh. Tarun Sachdev & Rohan Krishan, Authorised Representative of the Unit appear before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. The revised projections of the Unit are as under:-

2.1.3 The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, **approved** the proposal for inclusion of additional authorized operations and revision in projection for the current block under Proviso (1) of Rule 19(2) of SEZ Rule 2006 subject

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to submission following documents:-

- (i) Unit needs to submit value-wise of list of proposed indigenous & import Services for Rs. 2417.20 lakhs & Rs. 86.20 lakhs as per approved default list of 67 services.
- (ii) Unit also needs to Clarify regarding realization of export proceeds as to whether the payments have been received in INR or in Free foreign exchange.

2.2 M/s Aussiemelba Makhan Private Limited:

2.2.1 It was informed to the Committee that M/s Aussiemelba Makhan Private Limited has submitted proposal for inclusion of additional authorized operation i.e. "Spices and Spices Powder, Food Ingredients & Permitted Food Colours, Besan Products, Dry Fruits & Nuts, Packaging Materials / Gift Boxes" and revision of projections in the Letter of Approval.

2.2.2 Shri Manik Yash, Director of the Unit joined the Meeting virtually before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. The revised projections of the Unit are as under:-

2.2.4 It was also informed that the list of packing materials / gift boxes. the HS Code 4819 for Paper / Cardboard Gift Boxes should be given in 8-digit instead of 4-digit. The HS Code 44209090 for Wooden Gift Box is Restricted and the Unit should follow the Policy Condition of HS Code 44209090.

2.2.5 The Committee has noted that the Unit will procure all the raw materials indigenously and no import of raw materials has been envisaged.

2.2.6 The Committee discussed the proposal in detail and after due deliberations, **approved** the proposal with a direction to the unit to submit (i) revised Online form F3 (application for broad banding); (ii) and revised HS Codes of proposed items of manufacture.

Item No. 3: Permission / Clarification regarding Import of Prototype Motorcycle for Engineering & Design Activities under Rule 27 of SEZ Rules, 2006

3.1 It was informed to the Committee that M/s Triumph Motorcycles India Private Limited has submitted proposal for seeking permission/clarification for import of one (01) prototype motorcycle from its overseas group company (Triumph UK) for engineering evaluation, design validation, benchmarking, testing, and product development in connection with its approved LOA service activities.

3.1.2 Sh. Tarun Sachdev & Rohan Krishan representatives of the unit submitted that the prototype motorcycle is strictly intended for internal technical evaluation within its SEZ premises, will not be used for commercial sale, will not be registered under the Central Motor Vehicles Rules (CMVR), and will not play on public roads. It was argued that SEZ is a deemed foreign territory under Section 53 of the SEZ Act, 2005, and hence the port-specific import restriction under Chapter 87 of ITC(HS) Policy should not restrict direct duty-free import into the SEZ.

3.1.3 Specified officer of Mahindra World City has submitted their Report dated 16.09.2026 which was placed before the Approval Committee meeting. As per the report, the R&D exemption provided under the Import Policy is specifically for a vehicle manufacturer and auto components manufacturer. Since M/s Triumph Motorcycles India Private Limited is an Engineering and Design Service provider, and not a vehicle / auto components manufacturer, the said exemption cannot, prima facie, be extended to the

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unit merely on the ground that the motorcycle is a prototype intended for R&D activities.

3.1.3 The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, **DEFER** the proposal for next UAC and advised the Unit to take legal opinion in the matter. The Committee also directed office of DC, NSEZ to take legal opinion in the matter that whether an R&D Unit may import motorcycle for R&D activity or not.

Item No. 4: Proposal for Change in Partnership Deed - Profit-loss share ratio in terms of Instruction No. 109 dated 18.10.2021

M/s Knitpro International

4.1 It was informed to the Committee that M/s Knitpro International has submitted proposal for change in profit-loss share ratio of the firm.

4.2 Shri Shirish Jain, Authorised Representative of the Unit appear before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal.
