Minutes of Meeting regarding cleanliness and general issues of NSEZ held on 14.10.2014 under the Chairmanship of Sh. Sumet Jerath, Development Commissioner, NSEZ, in the Conference hall, NSEZ Service Centre.

The following officers were present:

- 1. Sh. Sharad Srivastava, Specified Officer, NSEZ
- 2. Smt. Malarangarajan, DDC, NSEZ
- 3. Sh. Rakesh Kumar, DDC. NSEZ
- 4. ADC's/Appraisers & Superintendent, NSEZ

Apart from the above, representatives of NSEZ Association and units have attended the meeting.

1. Cleanliness Drive:

DC informed to the units that NSEZ authority is keen in general upkeep, maintenance and beautification of the zone. To achieve this target following suggestions were received:

(a) Deployment of Dustbins in the designated Areas:

Although there are garbage dustbins are kept at designated places in the Zone, but NSEZ authority will identify more places and the information about the places of these dustbins will be intimated to the units.

(b) Deployment of Dustbin outside of each unit:

Mr. Rohit Kayal of M/s Sparta Infotech suggested that they have kept dustbin outside their unit. Similarly, all units are advised to keep such small dustbin outside their unit. The details of such vendor of dustbin would be sent by Mr. Rohit Kayal to Mr. Rakesh Kumar, DDC NSEZ.

(c) Non-production waste collection:

Helpline, designated garbage collection agency shall collect the non-production wastage from each unit at the designated time every day. If any unit is not getting this service, the same may be brought to the notice of DC office.

(d) Paper, old cartons & other packing waste except metals:

Mr. Sharad Srivastava, Specified Officer, NSEZ, informed units that above mentioned waste can be taken outside the zone without payment of duty.

(e) Building Materials etc. lying outside the units:

Mr. Rakesh Kumar, DDC informed that there some units who are perpetual offenders and don't remove the building material etc. lying outside their unit for several weeks despite several reminders. In these circumstances, the DC office will have no choice but to take penal action against such errant units.

(f) Cleanliness in SDFs:

In some blocks, it is observed that the drainage pipes have rusted or there are no drainage pipes at all. In this regard, DC office have already called for the estimates from the designated agencies and the work will be awarded soon.

2. Street Lights in SEZ:

Units have informed that some of the street lights are not working in the zone. Units are advised that the same may be brought to the notice of DC office.

3. Power availability:

Units have informed despite the fact that NSEZ is declared Public Utility Status to NSEZ by Government of Uttar Pradesh, the power cut in the Zone is very high. It has been decided to take up this matter with UPPCL.

4. Customs gate Timing for material:

Specified Officer, NSEZ, informed to the units that the customs timing for material clearance at the gate is from 6:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. on all seven days of the week.

5. Import clearance issue:

Normally, SEZ Unit have to present original Delivery order to get the escort permission from NSEZ Customs. Since, the Airport/ Dry ports are in Delhi, it takes one extra day to get the clearance of goods. JCC assured the

units that he will look into the possibility of allowing the escort permission on the basis of scanned copy of Delivery Order.

6. Meeting with State Govt. Officials:

On request from the units, DC agreed to hold meeting with SEZ Units at-least once in every quarter. In the said meeting the concerned officials from different State Govt. Departments would be invited as well.

7. Entry Passes for Vehicles and the entry fee for the visitors:

Unit has informed that after imposing of entry fee of Rs.10/- there is a heavy traffic jam at the gate No.1 & 2 on the peak hours and requested to remove the same. It has been decided that to review the same in the next NSEZ Authority meeting.
