Minutes of meeting of the Approval Committee of Noida SEZ held under the Chairmanship of Shri A. Bipin Menon, Development Commissioner (DC), Noida SEZ at 02:00 PM on 22/09/2025 through hybrid mode.

A. The following members of the Approval Committee were present during the meeting:-

- (1) Shri Kiran Mohan Mohadikar, Deputy Development Commissioner, NSEZ (Nominee of Department of Commerce in terms of letter dated 23/09/2008).
- (2) Shri A.K. Bhushan, Deputy DGFT, O/o Additional DGFT, CLA, New Delhi.
- (3) Shri Saibal Roy, Assistant Commissioner, Customs, Noida Commissionerate.
- (4) Smt. Alka Mishra, Tax Recovery Officer, Income Tax Department, Noida.

B. Besides, during the meeting S/Shri (i) Ravikesh Tripathy, Specified Officer, NSEZ, (ii) Pramod Kumar, Steno-I; and (iii) Bharat Bhushan, Assistant, Project Section, NSEZ were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the stipulated quorum for holding the meeting was available and meeting could proceed.

C. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After a brief introduction, the agenda was taken up sequentially. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the units, following decisions were unanimously taken:-

D. Item wise decisions on proposals included in agenda:

(1) Ratification of Minutes of last meeting of the Approval Committee held on 09/09/2025.

It was informed to the Approval Committee that there were neither any references nor objections against the decisions of the Approval

Committee held on 09/09/2025. Hence, the Approval Committee took note of the same and accordingly, the Minutes of the meeting held on 09/09/2025 were unanimously ratified by the Approval Committee.

(2) Rajeshwari Essentials Private Limited - Setting up a new unit in NSEZ.

2.1 Shri Nishant Yadav, authorized representative of the company appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. Shri Yadav informed that they would do manufacturing, packaging and labelling of 'Flavoured Chewing Tobacco' under the brand name "PRIME" at their proposed unit in NSEZ. The company will then supply the entire finished product to RK Retail Trade Private Limited situated at SDF No. H-03(B), NSEZ. Thereafter RK Retail Trade Private Limited will export the final product to Thailand and other International Markets. He further informed that their operations would be 100% export oriented and they will not do any sales in Domestic Tariff Area (DTA). He further also stated that all the capital goods as well as raw materials shall be procured from DTA.

2.2 It was informed to the Approval Committee that some discrepancies were observed in the application which were required to be rectified by the applicant. The Approval Committee enquired on the license for manufacturing of Tobacco Products to which the applicant responded that they would submit a copy of the same as soon as they get it.

2.3 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved in-principle the proposal of M/s. Rajeshwari Essentials Private Limited for "**Manufacturing of Flavoured Chewing Tobacco(24039910)**". This would be subject to the condition that unit shall start production only after getting the license for manufacturing of tobacco products and no DTA sale of manufactured products shall be allowed. The applicant was requested to provide HS codes of all their raw materials and capital goods along with manufacturing flow chart. The Approval Committee further empowered the office of DC, NSEZ to examine the reply against discrepancies and consider final approval for issuance of LOA on file.

(3) Matter related to review of conditions being mentioned in LOAs related to Export/ Import/ DTA procurement of Restricted

& Prohibited goods.

3.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, directed the Project Section to examine the matter on case to case basis. It was also decided to await and take into account the outcome of the discussions being held in the Department of Commerce.

(4) Gopal Aromatic Private Limited- Enhancement of indigenous capital goods.

4.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal of M/s. Gopal Aromatic Private Limited for enhancement in the value of indigenous capital goods from Rs. 16.00 Lakhs to Rs. 172.75 Lakhs.

(5) Neokraft Global Private Limited - Inclusion of additional authorized operations in LOA.

5.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal of M/s. Neokraft Global Private Limited for inclusion of '*Manufacturing of Electric Space Heating Apparatus (Electric Heaters) (85162900)*' in the authorized operations. The approval however shall be subject to submission of annual production capacity of the proposed item and business plan for its export, including market of export of the product.

(6) Global Dent Aids Private Limited - Request for permission to establish a Common Creche facility for Unit-1 & Unit-2 Employees.

6.1 It was informed to that the unit has requested for permission to set up one common crèche at ground floor of Plot No. 91 for their both units located at Plot No. 91 (unit 2 also working on sharing on this plot), 173, 174, 175, NSEZ. The room will be located outside the production area, specifically at the right corner of the building and will measure approximately 7 feet x 15 feet.

6.2 The Approval Committee, discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal of M/s. Global Dent Aids Private Limited to set up one common crèche at Plot No. 91, NSEZ for both their units subject to compliance with Instruction No. 95 dt.

11.06.2019 and other applicable provisions in the matter.

(7) Vidya Mantra Edusystems Private Limited - Change in Director & shareholding pattern.

7.1 It was informed that deficiencies were observed in the application and unit needs to submit information/ documents observed in the file/agenda note.

7.2 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, took note of the change in Directors and shareholding pattern of the unit. However, the approval is subject to submission of information/ documents as observed in the file/agenda note.

(8) Aarshi Overseas Private Limited - Inclusion of Warehousing of Liquor under ITC(HS) 2203 to 2208 in LOA.

8.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail taking into account the sensitivity of the product in terms of high duties, challenges in valuation with respect to DTA sale and threat of diversion. After due deliberations, it directed that the some of the following parameters be considered for allowing warehousing of liquor for new units:

- i. experience of the unit in the line of business?
- ii. whether the unit is engaged only in warehousing in the SEZ or the warehousing operations are in addition to the existing manufacturing/ trading/ services operations in the LOA?
- iii. whether the unit is a AEO Logistics Operator,
- iv. whether the unit has a Star Export House Status
- v. whether permission from State Excise Department to warehouse & supply such shipment into DTA is available ,
- vi. whether there is adequate infrastructure for warehousing;
- vii. export turnover of the unit
- viii. whether there were any violations by the unit of any laws and regulations related to business activities or are there any pending investigations/ actions?

8.2: The Approval Committee further empowered the office of Development Commissioner, NSEZ to examine the documents submitted by the unit and take appropriate decision for inclusion of Warehousing of Liquor under ITC(HS) 2203 to 2208 in LOA on file.

(9) Ajit Exports - Review/Renewal of LOA & monitoring of performance

9.1 It was informed to the Approval Committee that based on the Intelligence received and developed by DRI New Delhi, it came to notice that the unit and its promoters were involved in misusing the facilities extended under Special Economic Zone scheme and were exporting metal scrap to fulfil the export obligation by mis-declaring the same as Gold jewellery and while importing brand new high end gold jewellery as raw material by mis-declaring the same as out dated & old jewellery then clandestinely diverted to various parties located in Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, etc. Accordingly, an SCN dated 30.04.2009 was issued to the unit by this office and LOA of M/s. Ajit Exports was suspended on 01/12/2009. Besides, the LOA has already been expired on 31/12/2013 while being under suspension.

9.2 It was further informed that Partner of M/s. Ajit Exports has also been allegedly found to be involved in illegal activities of diversion of duty free imported gold and diversion of gold jewellery in cases of some other NSEZ units also.

9.3 No one from the unit appeared for the meeting.

9.4 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, decided to grant one more opportunity to hear the unit and empowered office of DC, NSEZ to grant a personal hearing to the unit for adjudication of SCN dated 30.04.2009 on file.

Decision on Supplementary Agenda

(10) Trident Corp. - Inclusion of Warehousing of items under ITC Chapter 08 and Liquor under ITC(HS) 2203 to 2206, 2208 & 2209 in LOA.

10.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail taking into account the sensitivity of the product in terms of high duties, challenges in valuation with respect to DTA sale and threat of diversion. After due deliberations, it directed that the some of the following parameters be considered for allowing warehousing of liquor for new units:


- i. experience of the unit in the line of business?
- ii. whether the unit is engaged only in warehousing in the SEZ or the warehousing operations are in addition to the existing manufacturing/ trading/ services operations in the LOA?
- iii. whether the unit is a AEO Logistics Operator,
- iv. whether the unit has a Star Export House Status
- v. whether permission from State Excise Department to warehouse & supply such shipment into DTA is available ,
- vi. whether there is adequate infrastructure for warehousing;
- vii. export turnover of the unit
- viii. whether there were any violations by the unit of any laws and regulations related to business activities or are there any pending investigations/ actions?

10.2: The Approval Committee further empowered the office of Development Commissioner, NSEZ to examine the documents submitted by the unit and take appropriate decision for inclusion of additional Warehousing goods in LOA on file.


(11) Hanung Toys & Textiles Limited, Plot No. 108, 109, 110, 111 & 125, NSEZ - Application for Revival / Renewal and modification of LOA - Pursuant to NCLT Order dated 28/02/2024.

11.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, directed the unit to submit complete business plan along with details of the authorized operations i.e. IT/ITES & their CPC Codes. The Approval Committee further recommended the proposal for revival / renewal of LOA, modification of authorized operations for consideration by the BOA under SEZ rule 72. The Approval Committee also decided that proposal for grant of permission for "Trading of Textile" shall be considered restricted to clearance of old stock lying in the premises proposed to be taken over by the unit. The Approval Committee further directed the Project Section that after receipt of requisite information/documents from the applicant unit, proposal may be forwarded to BOA with complete facts and recommendation of Approval Committee for further consideration in the matter by BOA.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
