**Minutes of the meeting of Approval Committee, NSEZ held on 24/03/2026****नौएडा विशेष आर्थिक क्षेत्र****(दिनांक 24/03/2026 को आयोजित अनुमोदन समिति की बैठक का कार्यवृत्त)****Minutes of meeting of the Approval Committee of Noida SEZ held under the Chairmanship of Shri Vimal Anand, Development Commissioner (DC), Noida SEZ at 03:00 PM on 24/03/2026 through hybrid mode.**

A. The following members of the Approval Committee were present during the meeting:-

- (1) Shri Paras Mani Tripathi, Jt. Development Commissioner, NSEZ (Nominee of Deptt. of Commerce in terms of letter dated 23/09/2008).
- (2) Smt. Aashima Chawla, Dy. DGFT, CLA, New Delhi (Nominee of Zonal Joint Director General of Foreign Trade, Delhi)
- (3) Shri Saibal Roy, Asstt. Commissioner, Customs, Noida Commissionerate (Nominee of the Commissioner of Customs, Noida Customs Commissionerate, Gautam Budh Nagar).
- (4) Smt. Alka Mishra, Income Tax Officer, Income Tax Deptt., Noida (Nominee of the Principal Commissioner of Income Tax, Noida).
- (5) Shri Rajender Kumar, Asstt. Commissioner, DIC, Noida ((Rep. of Principal Secretary, Industry, Govt. of UP.).
- (6) Shri Vinay Kumar, Manager, Noida Authority (Nominee of the Chief Executive Officer, New Okhla Industrial Development Authority).

B. Besides, during the meeting S/Shri (i) Gya Prasad, Dy. Development Commissioner, NSEZ; (ii) Ravikesh Tripathy, Specified Officer, NSEZ; (iii) Rajnish Kumar, Superintendent, NSEZ Customs; (iv) Bharat Bhushan, Assistant, NSEZ; and (vi) Smt. Aakanksha Rathi, Preventive Officer, NSEZ were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the stipulated quorum for holding the meeting was available and meeting could proceed.

C. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After a brief introduction, the agenda were taken up sequentially. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the units, following decisions were unanimously taken:-

**D. Item wise decisions on proposals included in agenda:****(1) Ratification of Minutes of last meeting of the Approval Committee held on 29/01/2026.**

It was informed to the Approval Committee that there were neither any references

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nor objections against the decisions of the Approval Committee held on 29/01/2026. Hence, the Approval Committee took note of the same and accordingly, the Minutes of the meeting held on 29/01/2026 were unanimously ratified by the Approval Committee.

**(2) Aksasia Creations Pvt. Ltd. – Exit and transfer of assets and liabilities including building at Plot No. 142-I, NSEZ to M/s. Prabhat Zarda Factory (Overseas) in terms of Rule 74A of SEZ Rules, 2006.**

2.1 The Approval Committee, discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, decided to extend the validity of LOA of Aksasia Creations Pvt. Ltd. for six months i.e. from 01/01/2026 to 30/06/2026 exclusively to complete exit formalities subject to condition that no permission for fresh import or DTA procurement shall be allowed during the extended period.

**(3) Balaji Export Co. – Monitoring of performance in terms of Rule 54 of SEZ Rules, 2006.**

3.1 The Approval Committee monitored the performance of the Unit on the basis of APR submitted upto 2024-25 and observed that unit has been lying non-functional and has not made any exports 2020-21 onward.

3.2 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, directed to issue a Show Cause Notice for penal action to the unit for non-performance since 2020-21.

**(4) Cadence Design Systems (India) Pvt. Ltd. – Change in director**

4.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, took note of change in director of the company in terms of Instruction No. 109 dated 18/10/2021.

**(5) Enphase Solar Energy Pvt. Ltd. - Monitoring of performance in terms of Rule 54 of SEZ Rules, 2006.**

5.1 The Approval Committee monitored the performance of the unit in terms of Rule 54 of SEZ Rules, 2006 and noted achievement of positive NFE Earnings by the unit during 2021-22 to 2025-26 on the basis of APRs submitted upto 2025-26. The Approval Committee also noted that no foreign exchange realization has been shown pending as on date.

**(6) Interra Infotech (India) Private Limited - Change of company name to “Interra Information Technologies (India) Private Limited” subsequent to**

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6.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, took note of change of name of company to "Interra Information Technologies (India) Private Limited" subsequent to Merger/ Amalgamation of companies along with change in director & shareholding pattern of the company in terms of Instruction No. 109 dated 18/10/2021.

**(7) J & S Exports – Review of LOA.**

7.1 Ms. Rudrali Patil, representative of the unit, appeared before the Approval Committee. The Committee reviewed the performance of the unit and observed that no exports have been effected since FY 2016–17. It was further observed that the unit has neither generated any employment nor earned any foreign exchange since long time. The Approval Committee also noted that, during the its meeting held on 25.08.2025, Shri Dhruv Jalan, Partner of the unit, had accepted that a personal loan had been availed from HV Text & Garments Pvt. Ltd., against which documents of the NSEZ unit premises was furnished as surety. Further, lease rent amounting to Rs. 5,02,153/- (for four quarters up to 31.03.2026) remains outstanding against the unit.

7.2 The Approval Committee noted that despite repeated opportunities, the unit has failed to undertake any export activity, in contravention of the terms and conditions of the LoA and the provisions of the SEZ Act, 2005 and SEZ Rules, 2006. The complete absence of exports, employment generation, and foreign exchange earnings defeats the very objective of the SEZ Scheme and constitutes a gross violation of the intent and provisions of the SEZ Act and Rules. The act of creating third-party interest in the SEZ premises without prior approval of the Competent Authority is in violation of Rule 11(5) of the SEZ Rules, 2006. Further, the failure to achieve positive Net Foreign Exchange (NFE) is in violation of Rule 53 of the SEZ Rules, 2006. The outstanding lease rent also reflects non-compliance with the terms and conditions of allotment. It was also noted that the validity of the LoA expired on 30.06.2023 and no valid justification has been furnished for extension under Rule 19(4) of the SEZ Rules, 2006.

7.3 In view of the above, including persistent non-performance, non-fulfilment of NFE obligations, absence of employment and foreign exchange earnings, unauthorized encumbrance of SEZ premises, and non-payment of dues, the Approval Committee found no merit in the request for renewal/extension of the LoA.

7.4 The Approval Committee, after due deliberations, in exercise of powers



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conferred under Section 16 of the SEZ Act, 2005 read with Rule 19 of the SEZ Rules, 2006, decided not to renew the LoA beyond 30.06.2023 and to treat the LoA as expired with effect from its date of expiry. The Committee further directed that necessary action be initiated for issuance of exit notice to the unit under Rule 74 of the SEZ Rules, 2006.

**(8) Odin Digital Solutions LLP – Setting up a new unit in NSEZ**

8.1 Shri Rishi Verma, Shri Pradeep Tyagi & Shri Tahir Hassan, Authorized representatives of the company appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. Shri Verma informed that they have back-to-back arrangement with the Telex Corp. Telex will provide faulty and damaged mobile and other IT assets along with spares if required to them. They in turn will repair and refurbish the same and re-export. He further stated that they are also in discussion with other leading companies engaged in the same business in USA and other parts of the world.

8.2 It was informed to the Approval Committee that a physical verification of the registered office of the company was undertaken wherein it was observed that it was a residential apartment and there was no signboard or any name plate of the company there and that it was locked. On asking the security guard there about the said premises it revealed that it was a residential flat and no business activity was being conducted from there at present and the occupant were also not there for quite some time as told by the security guard. He couldn't provide any further information.

8.3 The Approval Committee observed that the items are sensitive in nature. The Approval Committee further observed that as per submitted balance sheet, the applicant company appears to be non-operational and has been incurring losses since FY 2021–22. The Committee further noted that the applicant has not been able to establish the existence of existing infrastructure and experience for undertaking the proposed activities. In view of the above, the proposal was found to be not tenable.

8.4 The Approval Committee after due deliberations and in exercise of powers conferred under Section 15 of the SEZ Act, 2005 read with Rule 18 of the SEZ Rules, 2006, decided to reject the proposal of M/s. Odin Digital Solutions LLP for setting up a unit in NSEZ.

**(9) P. Mittal Manufacturing Pvt. Ltd. – Change in directors and shareholding pattern of the company.**

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9.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, took note of change in director and shareholding pattern of the company in terms of Instruction No. 109 dated 18/10/2021.

**(10) Romsons International - Change of company name/constitution to "Romsons Group Private Limited" subsequent to Merger/ Amalgamation of companies.**

10.1 It was informed to the Committee that unit vide its letter dated 23.03.2026 has informed that they wish withdraw its application for the change of name in light of the prevailing geopolitical situation and pending Middle East orders that cannot currently be dispatched, proceeding with the amendment may lead to further delays due to product registration issues.

10.2 The Approval Committee took note of the request of unit for withdrawal of application.

**(11) Trident Corp. – Inclusion of additional authorized operations in LOA.**

11.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal of M/s. Trident Corp. for inclusion of "Warehousing of items i.e. Liquor under ITC(HS) 2203 -2206, 2208 & 2209 only for export and sale to Duty Free Shops / Bonded Warehouse" in authorized operations of unit.

**(12) Troy Exim India Pvt. Ltd. - Setting up a new unit in NSEZ.**

12.1 It was informed that M/s. Troy Exim India Pvt. Ltd. had initially submitted proposal for setting up a unit in NSEZ for 'Trading and warehousing with or without labelling, packing or repacking without any processing, assembly of completely knocked down or semi-knocked down kits for the items under HS Code 2201-2209, 2401, 3101-3105, 3301-3307'. The proposal was earlier taken up by the UAC in its meeting held on 12.01.2026 wherein the proposal was deferred with a direction to the applicant to submit detailed business plan mentioning source of procurement and destination of exports/sale of each item as well as processed involved/ to be carried w.r.t. each item and detailed source of funds for proposed project.

12.2 Now, the applicant has revised its proposal and proposed to carry out "(i) Trading and Warehousing of Liquor under Chapter 22 for export and sale to Bonded warehouse as well as (ii) Manufacturing of Cigarette". The applicant was requested to submit copy of Industrial License for manufacturing of Cigarettes

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which has not been submitted till date.

12.3 It was informed that the applicant had successfully bid for building at Plot No. 93 (1000 sq. mtrs.) conducted by this office through MSTC on 10.06.2025 with an auction amount of Rs. 1,90,13,288/-. The company had deposited Rs. 15,00,000/- as pre-bid EMD. Further, NSEZ Authority vide letter dated 26/06/2025 had requested to deposit the balance bid amount of Rs. 1,75,13,288/- within 30 days which the company failed to deposit. Further, extension of total 60 days for deposition of balance bid amount may had been allowed @12% per annum, on request of the unit, failing which bid was to be treated as cancelled and EMD forfeited. However, the company has neither applied for extension nor had deposited the remaining bid amount till date.

12.4 It was also informed to the Approval Committee that a physical verification of the registered office of the company was undertaken wherein it was observed that there was neither any sign-board nor business activity seen at the said premises. On asking the person present there about the said premises, it was found that it was a rented residential flat and no business activity was being conducted from there at present. Further, the owner of the said property told that the said premises was a residential flat rented to some other person and not to Mr. Gursewak Singh or Mr. Hardeep Singh, the present directors of the said firm. However, no copy of rent agreement etc. were shown. Also, at the time of physical verification, the occupants were not there and the said premises was found locked.

12.5 It was also informed that the applicant has proposed to invest Rs. 179 Crores in proposed SEZ unit. However, as per the ITRs submitted, the income of promoters are negligible i.e. approx. Rs. 2.5-4.5 lakhs per annum.

12.6 Ms. Manmeet Kaur and Shri Anshul Bhardwaj, representatives of the company appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. Ms. Kaur informed that as they were awaiting the decision of issuance of LOA, they did not pay the balance auction amount. They are ready to pay the balance auction amount along with interest. She further stated that initially they will start the project with trading & warehousing of Liquor only and Cigarette manufacturing will be done after obtaining Industrial License for the same.

12.7 Ms. Kaur further informed that they are a part of group of companies having sufficient turnover. However, this is a new company and the promoters will source the funds through Loan from bank and other financial ventures. She further informed that they will update the registered office address and submit the latest registered office address.

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12.8 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal of M/s. Troy Exim India Pvt. Ltd to carry out the activity of "Trading and Warehousing of Liquor under Chapter 22 for export and sale to Bonded warehouse", subject to the following conditions:- (i) the applicant shall deposit the balance bid amount along with interest within one week; and (ii) the applicant shall submit satisfactory reply on the observations regarding physical inspection along required documents.

**(13) RFB Gloves - Inclusion of additional authorized operations in LOA.**

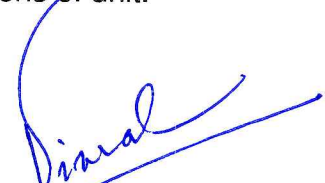
13.1 Shri Punya Ratra, Partner appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. Shri Ratra informed that they will manufacture Aprons of proposed different materials including rare earth materials which will be used for protection from Radiation.

13.2 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal of M/s. RFB Gloves for inclusion of "Manufacturing of (i) Articles and compounds of rare earth metals (28469020) (2000 Roll/annum); (ii) Other articles and compounds of rare metals (28469090) (100 earth Roll/annum); (iii) Articles of Lead (78060090) (250 Roll/annum); (iv) Antimony and articles thereof (81109000)(200 Roll/annum); (v) Tungsten and articles thereof (81019990)(200 Roll/annum); (vi) Bismuth and articles thereof (81069090)(250 Roll/annum); (vii) Xray Apparatus including parts and accessories (90229090) (600 Roll/annum); (viii) Outer garments, of fabrics, impregnated, coated, covered or laminated plastics (man-made fibre) for Industrial/medical (62102020) (200 Roll/annum); (ix) Articles of apparel & accessories, of vulcanised rubber, other (40159099) (200 Roll/annum)" in authorized operations of unit.
